1. What is the first step in becoming a successful Christian? What defines a “successful” Christian? What is the definition of “double-minded” in James 1:7-8?

3. How should we view outside influences in our lives? How do we decide which influences we allow to consume our time? What influences your life?
4. What should be our attitude to our life’s trials and difficulties as we seek to best develop our Christian single-mindedness? What first step is required to help us attain this quality? How can we find spiritual guidance? (See James 1:2-4,5-8)
5. How should we see ourselves if we are being called by God? How does God see us? (See James 1:9-11)
6. What can block our intent to prioritize spiritual fellowship with other Christians? What are two practical steps we can take to help our focus? (See James 4:1-5)
7. What are some ideas we can put in place to forgo our natural desires and honor God in our everyday lives? What is the danger of being double-minded in fellowship with other Christians? (See James 4:6-10, Joshua 24:15)
8. How can we reflect our Christianity to the world through our daily behavior? What should we continually be asking ourselves as we go through the day? (See Galatians 5:13-14,16-21)
9. What practical remedies does Paul give to prevent double-mindedness? What are Peter’s suggestions? What do we need to keep in mind when we are persecuted or ridiculed because of our devotion to Christ? (See Galatians 5:22-23, 1 Peter 1:11-12)
10. What does biblical prophecy say will be the fate of the present social world order? What should be our attitude as Christians towards politics and world events? (See 2 Peter 3:10-11,13)
11. How can we discern between earthly and spiritual wisdom? What must we guard against to prevent double-mindedness in relation to the happenings of the present day? (See 1 Corinthians 2:6-10, 2 Corinthians 10:5)
