2. What does it mean to give “glory” to someone or something? (See Matthew 5:16 and Matthew 6:1-4)
3. What example did Jesus give us as to how we should handle glory and where we should direct that glory? (See Matthew 9:6-8 and Matthew 15:29-31)
4. How do we handle opportunities of glory in our own lives? What principle should we use to keep ourselves in check? What does the example of Pharaoh’s heart teach us when we don’t keep that in check? (See Exodus 8:32 and 1 Corinthians 10:31)
5. Does everything we do glorify God? How can we be sure we are on the right path in glorifying Him? (See Colossians 3:23)

8. How can we give glory to God when we are going through trauma or difficult experiences in our lives? How do we need to see and understand the purpose of our experiences? (See Psalms 86:9-11 and 2 Corinthians 4:7-10, Romans 5:2-5 and Romans 8:28)
9. What lesson does Paul’s example of dealing with hardship have for us? (See 2 Corinthians 12:7-10)
10. How does working with others glorify God? (See Romans 15:6-9)
11. Why is it important to monitor our actions in how we glorify God? (See 1 Peter 4:11-14,16)
12. In reflecting on your own life, how do you glorify God? What else can you do to glorify Him?
