- 1. What is the dilemma Christians have in explaining the destiny of millions of people who lived their lives without hearing about Jesus and his plan of the redemption of mankind? Explain how these scriptures seem to contradict each other in describing the fate of humanity. (See John 5:28-29, 1 Timothy 2:3-4)
- 2. What was the purpose of the Law given to the people through Moses? What was Moses' role in presenting the Law? Why was a mediator needed? What were the consequences of idolatry? (See Deuteronomy 5:5,8-9)
- 3. Was the Law a permanent answer to bringing Israel back into favor with God? Did it work? Was the Law imperfect? What was its larger purpose? (See Galatians 3:19-21,24, Leviticus 18:5)
- 4. What does the promise to Abraham say? Who does it apply to? What opportunity did the Law bring to the Jewish nation? Why was the Law called a "tutor"? Who was the mediator for Israel after Moses died? (See Genesis 22:17-18, 12:1-3,7, 13:15-16, Galatians 3:24)
- 5. Who is the mediator between mankind and God? Why do we need a mediator? What is God's intention for mankind? (See 1 Timothy 2:3-6, Galatians 3:22-24)
- 6. What are the differences between the mediation of Moses and the mediation of Jesus? Describe the order and timing of Jesus' mediation. (See Romans 5:12, Acts 3:20-21, 2 Peter 2:9)
- 7. What is the ultimate purpose of Jesus' mediation and how will it give each individual an opportunity to have a relationship with God? Through which nation will the redemption plan come? (See Jeremiah 31:29-34)
- 8. What two groups of people benefit from the ransom? What roles does Jesus play with the different groups and why are these roles different? What are these roles called? (See 1 Timothy 4:10)
- 9. What does the Bible promise to the dedicated followers of Christ? What will be their role in the future? (See Galatians 3:25-29)
- 10. How does the church of the firstborn of Christ parallel the deliverance of the firstborn of Israel? How does the subsequent deliverance of the nation of Israel parallel the saving of the world? (See Galatians 3:25-29, Exodus 12:13, Hebrews 12:23, 1 Corinthians 5:7, 1 Peter 2:9,12)
- 11. List and discuss the 8 steps to God's plan to save all of mankind. What does this mean to you?
