1. What is the standard for leadership in the Bible? (See Mark 10:33,34) What example does God use to act as a model for good leadership? (See Psalm 77:20)
2. What is the first "E" of good leadership practices? How did Paul and Barnabas develop leaders? (See CQ Rewind; *quote from Brendon Burchard, Acts 14:21-23*)
3. What is God's instruction on where to find leaders within a fellowship? How were the leaders in the early church chosen? What does the word *ordain* actually mean? (See Acts 14:23, Mark 10:43-44)
4. What is the second "E" of good leadership? How did Peter apply this concept? What were his admonitions for leaders? (See 1 Peter 5:1-4, Romans 12:4-8)
5. What are four behaviors that do *not* belong in a good leader?
5. Name the third "E" of good leadership. What should be the aim of a good leader? Why should we all apply these principles of leadership in our lives? (See Romans 12:4-8, Hebrews 13:7,17, Acts 20:17-19,27,28)
6. What is the fourth "E" of good leadership? How should a Christian leader empower his followers? What is the difference between *enlisting* and *empowering*? (See Ephesians 4:11-13, 14-16)
7. What is the purpose of Christian evaluation, the fifth "E"? Who is to be evaluated? What examples of honest evaluation are shown in the Bible? (See 1 Corinthians 3:1-4, Hebrews 5:12-14)
8. What is the final "E" of good leadership that inspires and uplifts people? How can you apply this in your own life?
9. How can we encourage growth and development of those around us, and to lead others effectively in a godly way? (See 1 Peter 1:22, Romans 12:10, 1 Peter 4:11, John 15:11, Romans 12:11-12, 1 Corinthians 13:5-7, Matthew 25:20-21)
