- 2. What does the word "angel" actually mean? What are the different ways this word is interpreted in the Bible? (See Strongs #4397 in CQ Rewind)
- 3. Who did Gabriel visit, and what were his missions? Are angels sent to us for our daily problems? (See Daniel 9:21, Luke 1:19,26-27)
- 4. Who was Michael? What power and authority does the Bible say he has? What was Michael's main job in the Scriptures? Is there a connection between Michael and Jesus? Who was the Prince of Persia? (See Jude 1:8-9, Daniel 10:12-13, Daniel 12:1, 1 Thessalonians 4:16)
- 5. Do the Scriptures show that God wanted us to become familiar with angels? How does God use angels in their interactions with human beings? (See Galatians 1:8)
- 6. How does the Bible describe the power angels have? Is their purpose only to help individuals? How were they used in the Bible? (See Psalms 103:19-21, Galatians 1:8)
- 7. What limitations do angels have? Do they know everything about God's plan for mankind? (See Matthew 24:36, 1 Peter 1:12)
- 8. Was Jesus able to call angels to him while he was on earth? Can we call down angels as we go through our lives? (See Matthew 26:52-53)
- 9. Who has guardian angels at this time? How are guardian angels protecting and fighting for followers of Jesus? Who are they fighting on our behalf? (See Matthew 18:1-6,10, Psalms 91:11-13, Psalm 34:7, Hebrews 1:13-14)
- 10. How should we treat angels? Should we try to contact them? What are the negative results of violating the biblical guidelines of interacting with angels? (See Matthew 4:19, Colossians 2:18, Revelation 22:8-9, John 14:13-14)
- 11. What is the ultimate purpose of angelic help? Does it include removing all of life's problems for those who are protected? (See Acts 5:17-21, Acts 10:1-5,17-20)
