- 1. What are some possible reasons Scriptures may seem to contradict each other, and how can we determine what is true?
- 2. Does God promote or accept human sacrifice? (Compare Jeremiah 7:30-31 and Genesis 22:1-2). How can we reconcile these Scriptures?
- 3. How do we know Jepthah did NOT actually sacrifice his daughter to please God? (Judges 11:29-40) What is a clearer understanding of this account? (Hint think about context!)
- 4. Jesus sacrificed himself for us, and God actually DID require a sacrifice as part of a fulfillment of justice for Adam's sin. Does this mean that God accepts human sacrifices? How is Jesus different?
- 5. Does the Bible teach we should or should not kill? (Compare Exodus 20:13 and Leviticus 24:17-22)
- 6. Does God justify lying? How do we reconcile the many lies told in the Old Testament with God's position on lying? (See Exodus 20:16 and Leviticus 19:11)
- 7. What about Rahab? She not only lied, but God blessed her. How do we explain this?
- 8. Can God lie and deceive people? Does this fit in with His character?
- 9. Did God make Ahab lie? (See 1 Kings 22:3-23)
- 10. How and why do we know the Bible doesn't contradict itself, and why MUST the Bible be harmonious?
