1. Who is Jesus speaking to in the parables of the Lost Sheep, the Lost Coin and the Prodigal Son? What is the common theme of these parables? (See Luke 15:1-3)
2. What is the simple interpretation of the Parable of the Lost Sheep? What problems arise with this interpretation? (See Luke 15:4-7, Isaiah 53:6, Romans 3:23)
3. Who do the shepherd and the lost sheep represent in Jesus' parable? How does the Bible show this? (See Luke 15:4, Isaiah 6:8-9, Hebrews 10:5-7, Romans 5:12,15)
4. How was the lost sheep rescued in the parable? What does this represent in the plan of God? (See Luke 15:5, Isaiah 53:4-6, Matthew 16:24, Isaiah 9:6-7)
5. What happens after the sheep is rescued? What does this symbolize? (See Luke 15:6, John 14:28, 17:3-5, Proverbs 8:22-30, Luke 2:13-14, Revelation 5:11-12)
6. What could the coin and woman symbolize in the Parable of the Lost Sheep? (See Luke 15:8-10, 2 Corinthians 5:18-19)
7. What does the woman do to find her coin? What part of God's plan emulates this? Why? (See Luke 15:8, 1 Peter 2:12, Acts 3:19-21, 2 Peter 2:9)
8. What does the woman do once she finds the coin? What does this show about what is to come? (See Luke 15:9-10, Isaiah 2:3, 42:1-4, Zechariah 8:20-23, Micah 4:1-3)
9. What do the parables of the Lost Sheep and the Lost Coin teach us about God's love for us?
10. Where can you see evidence of God's love for all mankind? What can you do to show your love for Him and others?
