- 7. What is the big lesson of this parable? How can we use it to aid our self-evaluation?
- 8. Who is Jesus' intended audience for the Parable of the Unjust Steward? Who do each of the characters represent? (See Luke 16:1)
- 9. Why does the master fire his steward, and how does the steward respond? Why does this response receive the master's praise? (See Luke 16:2-8)
- 10. What is the lesson of this parable? How does it show God's love? (See Luke 16:9-13)
- 11. How do each of the four parables reveal God's love for mankind? Do you ever act in an entitled manner towards all the blessings He has given you? How will you change?
