SHOW NOTES

1. What are the scriptural definitions of jealousy and envy? How are they used in the Bible? (See Matthew 27:18, Mark 15:10, Romans 13:13, Galatians 5:26, James 4:2)
2. How can social media contribute to feelings of jealousy and envy? How can an understanding of who we are help us combat jealousy? (See Galatians 5:19-26)
3. Why is important to release our beliefs on how our life “should” look? How can this help us to replace our jealous thoughts? (See James 4:13-16, Titus 3:3,5)
4. Are envy and jealousy a part of human nature? What can we do when we have an evil, sinful thought? (See Proverbs 14:29-30, James 3:13-17)
5. How did King Saul’s pride and insecurity lead him to severe jealousy of David? How might we fall prey to similar thoughts within ourselves? (See 1 Samuel 18:5-9)
6. How have you been blessed in your life? How can you appreciate these blessings more in order to replace jealous and envious thoughts? (See Philippians 1:13-18)

8. How can we use exposure to the things that make us jealous to help us overcome our jealousy? (See Philippians 4:11-13)
9. What is the most important step to take to overcome jealousy within yourself? (See Romans 7:14-25)
10. Do you have jealousy and envy in your life? If so, what will you do to overcome it?
