- 1. Is God the author of confusion? If not, why did He cause confusion by altering the people's languages? (See 1 Corinthians 14:29-30,33, Genesis 11:7-9)
- 2. How can we use an understanding of flashback as a literary device to resolve events that seem to be out of order? (See Genesis 10:5, 11:1-4,7-9)
- 3. Does God live in darkness or light? Why is it written that He makes darkness His hiding place? (See Daniel 2:21-22, James 1:17, Psalms 18:7,9,11,27-29)

- 7. What provokes God's anger? Does it last forever? If not, what will follow its end? (See Jeremiah 17:4,31:34, Isaiah 53:6, Psalms 103:12-14, 1 Corinthians 15:25-28)
- 8. Does God ever forsake His children? Why did Jesus cry out that God had forsaken him on the cross? (See Psalms 10, 22:1, 21-22, Isaiah 53:6, Matthew 27:45-46, Luke 23:46)
- 9. Can we trust God to always deliver us? How does this deliverance come to us? (See Psalms 46:1-2, 145:17-19)
- 10. How can distinguishing between temporary emotion and eternal purpose help you understand how God is working in your life?
