- 1. On which day did God create the sun? (Compare Genesis 1:3-5 and Genesis 1:14-19)
- 2. When Genesis says God created the "heavens and earth," what is that referring to and why do we believe it to be true?
- 3. Did God complete His work by the end of each creative day? How does this help us to understand how science and the Bible work together and not against each other?
- 4. From whose perspective were the creative days written, and how does this help us to better understand why some of the Scriptures may seem contradictory (but aren't)?
- 5. Was Adam created before or after birds, trees, animals and Eve? (Compare Genesis 1:11,13,20-24 and Genesis 2:5,7-9,18-19)
- 6. If chapters one and two of Genesis are telling the same creation account why is there repetition, and what is the difference between them? (Hint: consider the perspective and their purpose.)
- 7. Why did God create the earth and everything on it, and what does that tell us about how He views creation? (See Genesis 2:7-9)
- 8. God tells Adam that the day he eats from the tree of good and evil he will die, however Adam lives for 930 years (See Genesis 5:4). Was God lying? How can we understand what God meant?
- 9. What do the first two chapters of Genesis tell us about God and how we should perceive Him?
