7. What symbolism is present in the Holy and the Most Holy?

8. What symbolism is in the three pieces of furniture of the Holy? (See Psalm 119:105, Psalm 141:2, Matthew 5:14, John 9:5,15:5, Ephesians 3:16, Revelation 1:20,8:3-4)
9. What symbolism do we see in the Courtyard?
(See Matthew 16:24, John 1:12, Romans 5:1, 8-9, Hebrews 10:1,4,5)
10. What is the big picture symbolism of the Tabernacle? What can we learn only through studying the Tabernacle? (See Romans 12:1-2, Ephesians 1:7-10, Revelation 13:8)
