1. Describe how you think of angels. What do you think they do for you? Do you talk to a guardian angel?
2. For these examples of spiritual beings who live in heaven, explain each being or type of being: (Isaiah 14:12, Ezekiel 28:11-16, Genesis 3:24, Nehemiah 9:6, Job 38:4-7, Genesis 6:1-5)
  - a. Sons of God – who is included in this group?
  - b. Lucifer – title in heaven, position in the Garden of Eden, his actions
  - c. Cherubim – assignment, description, difference from the common thought of a cherub
  - d. Heavenly hosts – who do they include?
3. Give the definition of the word “angel.” When are the sons of God in heaven called angels?
4. What happened when some of the sons of God came to earth just as *men began to multiply on the face of the land*? What were the results of this action? What might be attributed to this event? (Genesis 6:1-5)
5. Who were/are sons of God? How can this sonship be lost? (Luke 3:38, Job 38:7)
6. Explain the critical point in God’s plan that was the purpose for these angelic missions in the Old Testament: (Genesis 22:11-12, Daniel 9:20-24, Zechariah 1:12-17)
  - a. Abraham – why was Isaac important?
  - b. Daniel – what did God need Daniel to do?
  - c. Zechariah – what message was given to Zechariah?
7. Explain the purpose of these angelic missions in the New Testament: (Luke 1:18-19, 1:26-33, Acts 8:26-29, 12:7-10)
  - a. Zacharias – the unlikely birth of John the Baptist – why is this an important event?
  - b. Mary – the “impossible” birth of Jesus – why was this the most important event?
  - c. Philip – why did the angel need to give Philip directions – what was the purpose in talking to the eunuch?
  - d. Apostle Peter – why was Peter’s continued ministry important?
8. What is the meaning behind Jesus’ discussion of little children?
9. How should we view angels? What else have we received from our Father for our help? (Matthew 18:1-10, Psalm 91:11)
10. How are true believers “immensely privileged”? How does the Parable of the Lost Sheep and the Parable of the Lost Coin give us a look into the community in heaven? Do the angels know all about God’s plan? (Romans 8:14-16,29, Hebrews 1:13-14, Luke 15:10, Matthew 24:36, 1 Peter 1:12)
11. Should we expect a guardian angel to be at our command? Why should we be cautious if we seem to have an angelic communication? How can we be God’s messengers – operating as sons of God? (Matthew 4:5-7, 26:53, 2 Corinthians 11:13-15, Hebrews 13:1-3, Romans 12:10-13, John 13:34, Galatians 6:2)
12. What can you do this week to be an “angel” (messenger) of God for someone else? What do you think of angels now?
