1. Please discuss in brief each aspect from Part I that God holds in high esteem:
  - a. Reputation
  - b. Nature's Bounty/Precious Stones
  - c. Marriage covenant
  - d. Ransom
  - e. Promises of God
  - f. Human Purpose
  - g. Inappropriate Dishonor
2. High-Level Value of **Sincerity**: How can we be genuine and sincere? How do you deal with this? (Matthew 15:1-11)
3. High-Level Value of **Reverence for God**: (1 Timothy 1:16-17, 1 Corinthians 6:19-20, Revelation 4:11)  
How do we honor God? Explain the different ways mentioned. Can you add any ways you honor God?
4. High-Level Value of **Honoring All People**:
  - a. Are we to give equal honor on the same level to everyone? (1 Peter 2:13-20)
  - b. What does honor look like in servant/master, or boss/employee relationships? (Ephesians 6:5-9, 1 Timothy 6:1)
5. High-Level Value of **Honoring Family**:
  - a. Explain the guidance of **Ephesians 6:1-4**. Was verse 4 a surprise since this was given so long ago?
  - b. Do you see these verses as cherishing or demeaning to the family? Explain. (1 Peter 3:7, Colossians 3:18-21)
6. High-Level Value of **Honoring the Brotherhood**: (1 Timothy 5:1-3, 17-19)
  - a. How do we honor our shepherds, those who are our teachers? (verses 17-19)
  - b. In what way do we treat others in the brotherhood? What about widows? (verses 1-3)
  - c. What is intentional action according to **James 1:26-27**? How does **John 6:9** support this?
  - d. How is the body of Christ intended to work together? Explain *more abundant honor*. (1 Corinthians 12:20-26)
  - e. How do these verses describe the Gentile's journey into Christianity? (Ephesians 2:13-16)
  - f. How are we to treat all others? (Galatians 6:10, Romans 12:9-13)
7. High-Level Value of **All God-Based Honor** to us: (Hebrews 2:5-10)
  - a. In what way was mankind *crowned with glory and honor*? On what level? Why does verse 8 say, *Yet at present we do not see everything subject to them*? (verses 2:5-8)
  - b. Why is Jesus *crowned with glory and honor*? On what level? How does this compare with our honor? (verses 9-10)
  - c. What position are the *living stones* being prepared for? Who are these people? (1 Peter 2:4-7)
  - d. Do all people receive *glory, honor and immortality*? What is required to achieve this honor? (Romans 2:7-11, 8:18, 1 Peter 1:7-9)
8. Describe the scene in heaven surrounding God's throne. What will be the final position of Jesus in the heavens? (Revelation 5:11-13, Philippians 2:9-10)
