- 1. What is the Day of Vengeance? How does the Bible explain it? What do the descriptions in these verses symbolize? How does God's vengeance fit into His entire plan of salvation? (See 2 Peter 3:10,12, Isaiah 40:4-5)
- 2. In the Luke 4:18-19 account when Jesus was in the Temple, why did he stop reading in the middle of the Isaiah prophecy? How does the Lord's Prayer in Matthew 6:9-10 describe the stages of the establishment of God's kingdom?
- 3. What is the Day of Vengeance (also called the "day of visitation)"? When will justice be fulfilled? Who makes up the "royal priesthood" and what will be their role in the Day of Judgment? (See 1 Peter 2:9,12)
- 4. How does Psalm 145 encourage us as we anticipate the Day of Vengeance?
- 5. What are the three foundations for God's coming kingdom? What will be the effects on mankind as equity and justice are restored in the kingdom? Where will these effects begin? (See Revelation 11:15, Daniel 7:27, Jeremiah 31:27-33)
- 6. What is the ultimate point of Jesus' sacrifice? How does the Bible describe the transformation of Israel and its repercussions on the rest of the world? (See Jeremiah 31:34, Zechariah 8:20-23)
- 7. How will things on earth change when sin is removed during the kingdom? What do the verses in Psalms 145:11-16 say about God's character?
- 8. In the kingdom, what will happen to those who refuse to follow God's rules of righteousness? How do we know creation will be brought back into harmony with God? What resources will humanity be given to accept personal responsibility for their own care? (See Revelation 21:8, Isaiah 11:1-9, Isaiah 65:212-25)
- 9. How will humanity learn of God's government? How do we know most people will not be resurrected as spirit beings? (See Isaiah 2:2-4, Revelation 21:1, Psalm 145:17-21, Daniel 7:13-14)
- 10. What will be the effects of the kingdom on humanity and on the earth? (See Isaiah 35:4-7, Isaiah 35:8-10, Micah 4:1-5, Revelation 21:3-4)
- 11. Consider these wonderful prophecies of the future kingdom and how they will personally affect you and your family.
