SHOW NOTES

1. How did sin enter the human race? What is the remedy for this? When did God start planning for this remedy? Who is involved in this remedy? (John 3:16-17, 1 Peter 1:18-21, Ephesians 1:3-6)
2. **Who am I?** How can I be sure I appreciate the magnitude of the role in which I have the privilege to participate?
3. **Who am I?** How does the Old Testament connect with my inheritance in Christ? How does the Abrahamic Covenant apply to me? How can I know if I have been “clothed with Christ” and if I “belong to Christ”? (Genesis 22:15-18, Galatians 3:16,27-29)
4. **Who am I?** Am I truly reflecting my newly created life in Christ? Are my interactions with others a testament to God’s spirit and His justice, wisdom, power and love? What are my expectations of the future? (1 Peter 1:3-5)
5. **Who am I?** How do I exhibit to others (and in my heart) clear evidence of a self-sacrificing love? (John 15:12-14, 1 Corinthians 13:1-3,13)
6. **Who am I?** Do I have a deep and profound connection in accomplishing God’s purposes for me? How does 1 Peter 2:9-10 describe the role I am to fulfill?
7. **Who am I?** Am I excited yet humble in my anticipation of being with Jesus in heaven? (Ephesians 5:22-27, Revelation 19:7-8)
8. **Who am I?** How do I know if I am being transformed? How do I truly represent God’s holiness in an unholy world? (Ephesians 2:19-22, 1 John 5:1, 1 Corinthians 3:16-17, 2 Corinthians 5:17, 6:14-16, Romans 12:1)
9. **Who am I?** How am I living in unity with other disciples of Jesus? How am I contributing and graciously accepting help from others? (1 Corinthians 12:14-19, 26, Ephesians 4:11-13)

### Review Questions:

- How seriously do I take following Christ?
- Am I walking in Jesus’ footsteps because I want to reconcile humanity back to God?
- How do I show my developing maturity and spirituality in Christ in my life?
- Am I just a cheerleader for Jesus because I like being called a Christian?

- How am I actively working at preparing myself to become part of the “bride of Christ”?
- Reflect on 1 Corinthians 2:9—how does this inspire me?
