- 1. What does *adialeiptos* ("without ceasing") mean in 1 Thessalonians 5:17? Explain Paul's examples in the scriptures below and then give an example of how we can do this in our modern lives:
 - a. 1 Thessalonians 1:2-3 How does Paul remember the Thessalonians in prayer?
 - b. 1 Thessalonians 2:13 What does praying about past events reveal about gratitude?
 - c. Romans 1:9 How is this possible? How did bringing his blessings before God verify them?
 - d. Which of these four prayer types do you use? Give an example of when you might use it.
- 2. What does Philippians 4:6-7 teach about the relationship between prayer, supplication and thanksgiving? What are the differences between these three prayer components?
- 3. Why is it important to pair supplication with thanksgiving?
- 4. What does it mean to "pray in the spirit" in Ephesians 6:18? How does this relate to spiritual warfare? What is required to pray in the spirit when presenting big petitions and supplications to God?
- 5. What is the difference between "meaningless repetition" and repeating a deeply-felt prayer? (Matthew 6:7-8)
 - a. Is it okay to repeat a comforting scripture to ourselves?
 - b. Why should we bother to pray if God already knows what we need? (Isaiah 26:3, 41:10)
 - c. What is Paul asking for in Ephesians 6:18-20? Is it correct for us to ask others to pray for us?
- 6. What is the significance of the "supplications" (*hiketeria*, literally an olive branch wrapped in wool) in Hebrews 5:7-9? In what way does this deepen our understanding of Jesus' emotional intensity and spiritual surrender in prayer?
- 7. Why is it important to allow Jesus' words and the word of God to "abide" in us?
- 8. What should be the basis of our praying without ceasing? (John 15:7-8, Colossians 4:2-4, Hebrews 13:15)
- 9. How do we offer sacrificial praise? Have you been in a position to do this? Explain. (Job 1:21, Acts 16:25)
- 10. What does the phrase "fruit of lips" mean? How does this praise God? (Psalm 34:1)
- 11. How are you using the privilege of praying without ceasing in your communication with the Father? How might you improve?
