Zacharias: Luke 1:11-25, 57-63, 78-8

- 1. How did Zacharias' initial doubt (verses 18–20) and subsequent consequence help him deal with an overwhelming message from Gabriel?
- 2. What lessons on faith and quiet reflection can we draw from when God's word seems impossible?
- 3. How do the Old Testament prophecies tie to the future New Testament happenings? What was the nature of John's ministry? (Psalms 18:1-2, 105:8-10, 106:9-10, Malachi 3:1)
- 4. How did Zacharias describe Jesus? (Luke 2:51-52, Malachi 4:2)

The two mothers: Luke 1:26-56

- 5. What was Mary's reaction to the angel Gabriel's announcement? Compare her reaction to that of Zacharias and Hannah. (1 Samuel 2:1-2)
- 6. How did Elizabeth react to Mary's news?
- 7. Describe Mary's beautiful song of praise to God. (Luke 1:46-55, Psalms 98:1-2, 103:17-18, 107:9)
- 8. How do you respond when others receive a blessing or opportunity you hoped for? What practical steps can you take to celebrate others while trusting God's timing for your own life?

Simeon and Anna: Luke 2:25-38

- 9. What did Simeon see before anyone else in the world? (Isaiah 52:10. 9:2-3,6-7)
- 10. What did Anna see and prophesy to encourage Israel?

Practical application

- 11. In what areas of your life do you find it hardest to trust God's promises?
- 12. What do you think you need to do to cultivate Mary's submission to God's will? "Behold, the bondslave of the Lord."
- 13. Share the details of God's plan for the future salvation of man that were revealed at the time of Jesus' birth.
