

Ep. 1413: What Really Happened to Enoch, Moses and Elijah?

- 1. Moses:
 - a. Why might God have chosen to bury Moses in an unknown location? (Deuteronomy 34:4-8)
 - b. For what reason might Satan have wanted Moses' body? (Jude 1:8-9)
 - c. What would the Israelites have done with Moses' bones? What had God told Moses in Deuteronomy 34:4 that may have led to His hiding of Moses' body? (Genesis 50:24-26, Joshua 24:32)
- 2. What is the biblical definition of death? (Genesis 2:16-17, Ecclesiastes 9:10, Romans 6:23, 1 Corinthians 15:20-22)
- 3. What idols or sources of misplaced devotion do you personally need to be wary of in your life? Are you careful to strictly follow Christ rather than a spiritual leader or a tradition?
- 4. Elijah:
 - a. How was Elijah taken and where was he taken? State the two options discussed. (2 Kings 2:1,11-12)
 - b. Describe the range of meanings of the words translated "heaven," "the heavens," and "of the sky." (Genesis 1:9, 26, 22:7, Psalm 11:4, 2 Kings 2:1)
 - c. How do we know Elijah is not in heaven? (John 3:13, Colossians 1:16,18)
 - d. How can we explain Elijah writing a letter to King Jehoram of Judah after Elijah was supposedly dead? (2 Chronicles 21:11-14, Bonus Material)
- 5. Mount of Transfiguration: Matthew 17:1-13, Mark 9:2-13, Luke 9:28-36
 - a. What does "transfigured" or transformed mean? Who was transfigured in this vision?
 - b. How did Moses (representing the Law) and Elijah (representing the messages given by the prophets of God) point to Jesus as the fulfillment and centerpiece of God's plan? (Romans 10:4, Acts 3:21, Colossians 1:16-18)
 - c. How do we know this was a vision? (Matthew 17:9)
- 6. Enoch:
 - a. What happened to Enoch? (Genesis 5:23,24)
 - b. Why was Enoch special? (Hebrews 11:5)
- 7. Describe a time in your life when God's plan for you seemed mysterious but later revealed His wisdom?
